





The Institute counts more than one hundred and twenty priests and nearly one hundred seminarians and oblates. Numerous diocesan priests are affiliated to the Institute and many lay people also make up our spiritual family. Our Sister Adorers, who now number over sixty, support the ministry of our priests by their prayers and sacrifices.
